The Freedom Summit is a bi-annual conference that serves as a catalytic event to bring San Francisco Bay Area abolitionists, communities and organizations together around the issue of Human Trafficking.

Our goal is to illuminate tangible stories of personal sacrifice and commitment by victims and heroes that will serve to motivate, educate and activate all ages in attendance towards deeper engagement in the abolitionist movement. We believe that raising up an informed “citizen brigade” in the fight against human trafficking will be done largely by connecting the issue to personal realities and spheres of influence—where we shop, eat, do business, and play.

History Freedom Summit 2013

Freedom Summit 2013, organized by the Bay Area Anti-Trafficking Coalition (BAATC) and held at Harbor Light Church in Fremont, California in January 2013, became the **largest anti-trafficking conference in the U.S. to-date.**

- 2 days
- +1000 attendees (329 students)
- Keynote by Dr. Condoleezza Rice, Former U.S. Secretary of State
- 19 breakout sessions
- 35 expert/speakers
Including Justin Dillion, Bradley Myles, Department of Defense, Albright-Byrd, and more
- 55 anti-trafficking organizations at the Expo
Including Freedom House, IJM, Because Justice Matters, California Against Slavery, MISSSEY, Trade as One, Starfish Project, and many more
- Film screening of Volviendo, Hark, Not Today

The aim of Freedom Summit 2011 was to support a forum for informing and engaging Bay Area individuals and collective civic groups towards building a regional response to human trafficking.
